- IGCSE (Minimum D)
- IELTS (Minimum 5)
- TOEFL IBT (Minimum 70)
- Password Test (Minimum 5)
- Anglia Examinations (Minimum Intermediate) Michigan Language Assessment (Minimum ECCE 52)
- Cambridge GCE AS Level (Minimum C)
- University of Cambridge Exams (Minimum PET)

***For postgraduate programmes, all candidates must prove a minimum Proficiency/Mastery competency level regarding the English Language.**

Please read the eligibility requirements per programme with regards to minimum grades for qualifying.
