Keynote Speaker

Prof. Eleni Stavrou University of Cyprus

Professor Eleni Stavrou is Director of the MSc in HRM at the University of Cyprus and is involved in helping organizations with various human resource management issues. She has received her Ph.D. at the George Washington University, USA where she was Director of Programs and Operations at the Center for Family Enterprise. Her expertise includes: work-life issues; strategic and comparative human resource management; and intergenerational transitions in family firms. She has published widely including articles in various academic journals, like *British Journal of Management, Human Resource Management, Journal of Organizational Behavior, Journal of Business Ethics, Entrepreneurship Theory and Practice, International Journal of Human Resource Management and Journal of International Business Studies. Largely as a result of her initiative, the University of Cyprus is one of the few in Southern Europe and the Middle East to promote and publish research in the emerging field of family enterprise.*

Prof. Almuth McDowall Birkbeck University of London

Almuth is Professor of Organisational Psychology at Birkbeck University of London where she leads her department and is part of the school's executive team. Her research has been funded by the Ministry of Defence, the College of Policing, the Chartered Institute of Personnel and Development and the Home Office, as well as a range of other funders. Almuth has won awards for her research and her commitment to furthering the practice of psychology in the workplace in the UK. She regularly contributes to the media fuelled by her belief that research needs to speak to organisations directly to have impact and contemporary relevance. She is a Chartered Psychologist, Academic Fellow of the CIPD and Fellow of the International Society for Coaching Psychology. Alongside she is a practicing psychologist working with the private, public and third sector delivering bespoke assignments. Her research interests are varied and include diversity and neurodiversity, worklife balance and occupational health, and professional competence and coaching.

Prof. Amos Haniff Heriot-Watt University

Professor Amos Haniff is an expert in the field of project management. He has published research on project success, leadership, and the implementation of organisational strategy through projects. His current research area focuses on the strategic alignment of project networks, the implication of politics in projects and multi-agency theory.

He is a member of the APM Research Advisory Group and former Chair of the Association for Project Management (APM) Scotland where he has provided leadership, consultancy, and guidance to public and private sector organisations.

From 2017 to 2023, he also held the position of Pan-Dean of Heriot-Watt University providing academic leadership across campuses in Scotland, Dubai, and Malaysia. He is the university's Armed Forces Champion and serves as the Convenor of the Edinburgh Universities Military Education Committee. Professor Haniff teaches undergraduate, postgraduate, and executive-level courses in project management, including those aligned with APM professional qualifications.

Dr Constantinos Constantinou CIM

Dr Constantinos Constantinou is the Director of Research and Head of Undergraduate Studies, Nicosia at CIM-Cyprus Business School. He is also the Editor-in-Chief of *The Market: International Journal of Business* and has previously served as a post-doctoral Research Fellow and Associate Director of the Cyprus Centre for Business Research – CIM. He has also worked as a Research Fellow at the Centre for European and International Affairs at the University of Nicosia (UNIC), and in the Media and Communication Department of the European Defence Agency in Brussels. Further, he is a Senior Research Fellow at the CCBR – CIM and a reviewer for journals such as the *Journal of Marketing Communications*, the *Journal of the Academy of Marketing Science*, the *International Journal of Business Performance Management*, and the *Review of Marketing Science*.

At CIM-Cyprus Business School, he holds the position of Associate Professor of Marketing, acting as a lecturer for UWL/CIM undergraduate and postgraduate modules. In addition, he acts as a supervisor for UWL/CIM Masters students' dissertations and has served as the Project Manager for the launch of CIM's online MBA. Constantinos holds a PhD in Business Administration from the European University Cyprus (EUC), an MA in International Relations and European Studies from UNIC and an MBA/BA in European Studies from EUC. His research focuses on political marketing and communication.

Dr Derek Watson Sunderland University

Dr Derek Watson is an Associate Professor and Senior Fellow of the Higher Education Academy, founder of the Faculty 'Business Clinic' and the Doctoral lead for the University's 'Research Fridays' programme. Dr Watson has extensive links and networks as a result of sourcing and embedding external engagement opportunities across the curriculum, with an international portfolio of clients and contacts, such as the British Cabinet Office, Indian Government Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, Dubai Police and Canon International.

His research focuses on Food Safety Cultural Compliance and Academic-Industry collaboration, investigating the impact of knowledge exchange on practice in both the classroom and the workplace. He actively documents his consultancy experience via international academic journals and has delivered lectures and seminars at universities and symposiums on a global scale. He has been appointed on the editorial board for the 'International Journal of Academic Research in Management'. Dr Watson is also a Doctoral External Examiner, academic reviewer of several international journals and currently employed as 'External Examiner' for the University of West London doctoral programmes. In addition, his is also a Visiting Professor at the University of Panama in Food Culture and a Senior Research Fellow at the Cyprus Centre for Business Research – CIM-Cyprus Business School.

Dr Elena P. Antonacopoulou PhD is full time faculty at the American University of Beirut - Mediterraneo, in Cyprus. She previously served as tenured faculty (full professor) at Universities in the UK (Warwick, Manchester, Liverpool) and Canada (Western) and visiting professor in the UK (Lincoln University), Norway (Royal Norwegian Airforce Academy) and Cyprus (University of Cyprus, Nicosia) where she contributed through her teaching in the design and delivery of prominent programs at postgraduate (MSc and MBA) and post-experience levels (e.g. DBA). Her principal research expertise lies in The Future of Work, Organisational Learning and Strategic Resilience and Renewal, with a focus on the Leadership implications. She is published widely in international journals, edited books and policy reports. Her practice-relevant scholarship has earned her many research grands, awards and accolades recognising the impact of the ideas developed. She has and served (appointed or elected) in multiple leadership roles in the top professional bodies in the management field (AOM, EURAM, EGOS, BAM) and has received several awards for her outstanding leadership and service contributions and teaching excellence. She has successfully secured funding and led interdisciplinary, international multi-stakeholder research teams on high profile research programs funded by Research Funding Councils in the UK, EU and was invited to co-author policy and evaluation reports by professional bodies and Think Tanks designed to improve professional practices. She is frequently invited to deliver keynote speeches in international conferences, and workshops that inspire and promote action choices that serve the common good. She is a certified coach from the International Coaching Federation (and practises as an axiologist - enabling true-self breakthroughs) and she has founded the GNOSIS Institute to promote knowledge philanthropy and to avert 'humane poverty' by designing innovative leadership and organisational development programs.

Dr Panayiotis Hadjipavlis is a defence and aviation specialist with more than 30 years of experience in defence strategic analysis, military aviation, airspace geopolitics and flight safety issues. He is characterised by a comprehensive and interdisciplinary approach to analysing political and security related issues, a virtue attributed to his diverse academic background. Panayiotis graduated as a jet pilot from the Hellenic Air Force Academy, where he also earned a BSc in Aviation Science. He also holds a BA in European Studies (European University Cyprus), an MBA (University of Sunderland, UK), an MSc in Aviation Safety Management (City University, UK), a Master II in Religions, Cultures and Politics in Modern and Contemporary Europe (École Pratique des Hautes Études, France) and a Professional Master in Superior Military Studies from the French War College. In July 2021, he earned a doctoral degree in Geopolitics of the Airspace from Newcastle University, UK.

Panayiotis is a visiting lecturer at the Centre for Security and Intelligence Studies (BUCSIS) of the University of Buckingham, UK, a Research Associate of the Centre for European and International Affairs of the University of Nicosia, a Research Fellow of the Defence and Security Research Institute (DSRI) of the University of Nicosia and a Research Fellow at CERIDES Research Centre of the European University Cyprus. At the same time, he has been an associate editor to several academic publications while he has published several academic articles in various journals and books. Panayiotis' research interests include geopolitics of the airspace, techno-geopolitics, the geopolitics of the Eastern Mediterranean, Near East and Sahel regions, issues of state sovereignty and European defence cooperation.

As regards his professional career, Dr Panayiotis Hadjipavlis has been a Defence Director at the Cyprus Ministry of Defence since October 2023, Head of the General Procurement and Defence Capabilities' Development. Under his remit among other issues, are the European Defence Agency affairs and all the Defence Capabilities' Developments within the EU, the development of the local Defence Industry and the Research and Innovation for the Cyprus Armed Forces. As a retired Colonel, Dr Hadjipavlis has served in several critical posts at the Cyprus Ministry of Defence. In 2019 he was posted as a strategic analyst for the Sahel region in Africa at the EU Military Staff/ European External Action Service, while in August 2021 he assumed the post of the Head of the Africa Section of the EUMS Strategic Analysis Section.
